WHAT IS ON SITE: The Forest Centre provides a base for your visit. The Education Barn is somewhere to store your things, a place to work and eat lunch if too wet or cold to eat outside. There are toilets and washing facilities on site. The Information Barn has displays on the flora, fauna, history, management and archaeology of the Forest. There is also a small shop and children, if they have parental permission to buy items, should bring small change (please no notes!).

WHAT TO WEAR: Activities will continue irrespective of the weather. Please ensure children/pupils bring strong walking shoes and/or wellies as the Forest can be very wet and muddy particularly in the winter. Children/pupils will also need warm clothes and waterproofs. The Education Barn will be locked to ensure security when outdoor activities are taking place and keys will be made available.

COACH PARKING: Free coach parking is available at the Forest Centre for mini buses and small coaches. Broadstone car park should be used by larger coaches and the Forest Centre is a clearly signposted two minute walk away. Coaches must not pull into the Forest Centre yard as this is used by heavy machinery and is unsafe for members of the public.

INSURANCE: Sussex Wildlife Trust and The Conservators of Ashdown Forest have their own public liability insurance. Schools should ensure they have their own appropriate insurance for their pupils/children when engaged in activities on the Forest.
