



# High Weald Hero Activity Card

## Look, Remember, Find...



**Location:** An outdoor environment

**Audience:** KS1 & 2

**Equipment:** 10 objects gathered from the area around where you will be playing the game e.g. leaves, seeds, rocks, twigs. Paper/cloth for covering objects

**Time:** 20 minutes

*An observation exercise that encourages exploration*

**Activity description:** Collect 10 small interesting objects from the outdoor environment (twigs, leaves, feathers etc). Place the objects together and allow 30 seconds for the children to memorise them. Cover them up and then give the children 5 minutes to try and find as many things as they can remember. Bring the group back together and pull out an object, one at a time. Say what it is and an interesting fact about it. Ask the children if they have found that object or something similar.



**High Weald Teaching Point:** The High Weald's natural resources have been used by different people throughout history. For example, sandstone outcrops were used as shelters for Neolithic hunters and wood was used in Roman and Tudor times to fuel the growing iron industry.
