

Commemorated at Forest Row: Men who Fought and Died in the Great War

Introduction

To mark the anniversary of the start of the First World War, members of the Ashdown Forest Research Group have carried out research into the men who are commemorated on Forest Row War Memorial.

They were particularly interested in finding out more about the background of the men, drawing on sources such as the decennial census up to and including the 1911. They also researched the records of the men's military careers and found out more about the circumstances of their deaths and where they were buried. Any other information that was considered to be relevant, including possible familial or other connections between the men listed on the memorial, was also recorded.

The results have been compiled into an Excel spreadsheet. The following pages present the contents of that spreadsheet as a PDF document.

Sources

The data in the spreadsheet are drawn from the War Memorial in Forest Row, the Memorial Book at Holy Trinity Church Forest Row and a variety of online sources. These include Ancestry (<http://home.ancestry.co.uk>); Find My Past (<http://www.findmypast.co.uk>); the British Newspaper Archive (<http://www.britishnewspaperarchive.co.uk>); the Commonwealth War Graves Commission (<http://www.cwgc.org>); Spartacus Educational (<http://spartacus-educational.com>); and a few other sites devoted to individuals mentioned. Local knowledge has also been incorporated where it adds detail.

Reading the Spreadsheet

The spreadsheet as presented here consists of eight pages, alternating between the left and right hand sides of the spreadsheet as you move down the spreadsheet.

Individuals highlighted with red text had close family and geographical ties with Ashdown Forest, while those recorded in black had a looser connection to the forest.

Individuals whose names are highlighted in bold are included in our collection of case studies "*Men of Ashdown Forest Who Fell in the First World War and Are Commemorated at Forest Row, Hartfield and Coleman's Hatch*", which is available on this website.

Greyed-out cells are those for which we have found no information.
