

## **Ashdown Forest Conservators' Early Morning Bird Walks**

Assemble at 06.30hrs for 06.40 prompt start (venue to be advised a few days in advance).

A wonderful chance to take an early morning (6.40am to 9am approx.) guided walk on the Forest led by one of our voluntary Rangers, an experienced birdwatcher. The birds should be very active and vocal at this time. This is a chance to hear and see some unusual birds, which it is hard to find in Sussex outside Ashdown Forest.

1. Walk aimed at novices and non-birdwatchers.
2. Limited number of places so book early.
3. A maximum of two spaces per booking.
4. There is a small charge of £5 per adult, £2.50 children(10-15yrs)
5. Maximum 12 walkers per walk.
6. Open to adults and to children 10 years and over if accompanied by an adult.
7. Binoculars would be helpful though not essential.
8. Wear **sturdy boots** (could be some uphill/downhill walking) and country clothes (please –no bright red/yellow/blue colours)
9. Sorry no dogs.
10. Weather dependent - no walk if heavy rain on the morning of walk.
