The Conservators have a responsibility for the health and safety of its entire staff. When you are working as a volunteer you are included in this responsibility. To help the management of Health and Safety, staff are asked to indicate any health situations that they have, which may have a bearing on the type of work they are asked to do, e.g. asthma which could be aggravated by smoke inhalation.

To help the Conservators protect you, and to administer correct first aid should the need arise; it is necessary to hold any such information. This information would be held in a sealed envelope within the 1st Aid Kit and only opened by a qualified 1st Aider should the need arise. All staff working outside are qualified 1st Aiders and would respect the confidentiality of this information.
