

The Ashdown Forest Education Team are offering to come to your school to run a free outreach session.

This could be for one class, a year group or even a whole school assembly. You could use these sessions to prepare for a visit to the site or to follow one up. They will be delivered at a time that suits you.

Here are some ideas that other schools have used:

Local geography - find out about the plants, animals and landscape of your local area, how the site is looked after for conservation and exploring map work.

Local history the Ashdown Forest has been used by man since the stone age. Find out how it has changed over time and how people have impacted on the site.

Science - habitats, adaptations, plant identification, materials.

Art and design - using different materials and tools to create natural sculpture.



The sessions aim to help you discover more about aspects of the amazing natural environment on your doorstep and we hope they will inspire you to bring your school to visit the Forest and find out more. We are able to deliver sessions to any primary age children within 15 miles of the Forest.

We are only able to offer these sessions to schools that have not previously taken up this offer.
