The Hebridean is a breed of sheep with an historical reputation for producing delicious mutton. The Hebrideans from the Conservators' flock are particularly slow growing, fed on the natural heathland vegetation of the Forest and definitely in a class of their own.

Your box of Hogget will be processed locally and expertly cut. A whole box will consist of approximately 15 kg of Hogget, comprising:

- 2 legs on the bone
- Rack of lamb
- 2 shoulders
- loin chops and chump chops
- Mince

You can also order a half box which will be about 7.5kg

Enjoy this natural and tasty product in the knowledge that you are helping to conserve the rare and beautiful heathlands of Ashdown Forest.
